


# Interactive Case Conferences (ECHOs)



Dementia Care Aware has partnered with UCLA Health and UCI to provide virtual case conferences known as Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes (ECHOs). These case conferences give primary care teams the opportunity to learn about the cognitive health assessment and management of dementia through interactive and case-based live meetings with Dementia Care Aware experts.



Fridays from 12:00-1:00 PM, this all-teach, all-learn interactive case study series addresses following topics: Assessment Tools, Dementia Management, Pharmacology, Caregiver Support and Resources, Diverse Linguistic/Ethnic Community Supports, and Strategies to Manage Difficult Behaviors. Additional office hours are every 3rd Friday of the month from 12-1PM. Free CEs are available.

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Starting March 29, 2023, for 1-hour every two weeks, each session of this series reviews one of twelve topics. Participating organizations will have the opportunity to present and receive feedback on de-identified patients who are living with dementia. There are up to 12 free CEs available.
