

INCOME SUPPORTS AVAILABLE FOR OLDER ADULTS

CASH BENEFIT PROGRAMS FOR...	
People with Disabilities	<p align="center">Supplemental Security Income (SSI)</p> <p><i>For people who are disabled, blind, or over 65 with no or limited work history. Must have low income and resources to qualify. Maximum benefit amount for 1 is \$1,133.</i></p>
	<p align="center">Unemployment Insurance Benefits (UIB)</p> <p><i>For people who are unemployed and actively looking for work. Must have sufficient earnings in the lookback period with employers who paid into EDD to qualify.</i></p>
People with Work History	<p align="center">Social Security Retirement (SS-R)</p> <p><i>For people at retirement age (62+) with sufficient work history paying into SSA.</i></p>
	<p align="center">Pensions</p> <p><i>Many people are still entitled to pensions from former employers even when those companies move, merge, or go bankrupt.</i></p>
	<p align="center">State Disability Insurance (SDI)</p> <p><i>For people who cannot work due to a short-term disability. Must have sufficient work history paying into EDD to qualify.</i></p>
People with Disabilities + Work History	<p align="center">Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)</p> <p><i>For people who cannot work due to a long-term (12+ mo) disability with sufficient work history paying into SSA.</i></p>
	<p align="center">Private disability benefits</p> <p><i>Some people may be eligible for short- or long-term disability benefits offered as an employment benefit.</i></p>
	<p align="center">CalWORKs</p> <p><i>For low-income families with children.</i></p>
People with Families	<p align="center">Social Security Survivor/derivative benefits</p> <p><i>For dependents of deceased or disabled workers with sufficient work history paying into SSA.</i></p>

Immigrants	<p align="center">Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI)</p> <p><i>For aged, blind, or disabled non-citizens who are ineligible for SSI solely due to immigration status.</i></p>
	<p align="center">Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA)</p> <p><i>Up to 12 months of cash assistance for refugees.</i></p>
People with No Other Eligibility	<p align="center">General Assistance/General Relief (GA/GR)</p> <p><i>Small cash benefit for childless adults who are not eligible for any other cash benefit programs.</i></p>

CASH BENEFIT PROGRAMS FOR...	
Nutrition	<p align="center">CalFresh</p> <p><i>For low-income households under 200% FPL. Can be used to purchase groceries from any retailer that accepts EBT.</i></p>
