Dementia Care Aware offers many ways for providers and primary care teams to receive training on the cognitive health assessment (CHA) and other relevant dementia care topics. Check out some of the training opportunities below. All offerings provide free CE and CME/MOC



Cognitive Health Assessment Training

The cornerstone of the program is a course on a dementia screening approach called the cognitive health assessment. This training can be completed in our 90-minute self-paced e-Learning course or in a 1-hour webinar held twice a month. The online course offers 1.5 CE credits and the webinar format offers 1 CE credit

Additional E-Courses

Our online courses build upon the cognitive health assessment training to allow a more robust understanding of the CHA and its application. Topics include: The Cognitive Health Assessment for Team Members and Adapting the CHA. Each course offers .5 CE credits.

Monthly Webinars

1 CE credit given with live attendance, these 60-minute webinars present information on a variety of topics to assist with dementia care from screening to care planning and implementing dementia care processes into your workflow.

Podcasts

Dementia Care On-Air is a 30-minute podcast that can be streamed on podcast platforms and is intended to supplement the webinars and CHA training with a more casual conversational delivery. Each episode offers .5 CE credits
