


Begin with Detection: The Cognitive Health Assessment

Screen patients older than age 65 annually (who don't have a pre-existing diagnosis of dementia)





Next Steps After a Positive Screen – A Care Pathway

A training program that provides health care teams with the skills and confidence to include family caregivers in a patient's care journey.




